Student Volunteers will be able to attend sessions on the day they are not required for work and will be able to access all sessions virtually after the conference, via the EventsAir platform.

Student Volunteers will be required to undertake a training session for volunteers as well as the training session for EventsAir users.

In the tradition of the ASA assisting full time archival students, these six Student Volunteers will be able to attend the conference for free.

You will be required to undertake the following tasks in a polite and respectful manner.

- Attend the Information Desk during your rostered times.
- Answer queries from in-person attendees.
- Assist with the use of EventsAir (the Conference App) for in-person attendees.
- Assist with registrations for the ASA's AGM.
- Direct attendees from the Mander Jones Awards to the Welcome Drinks.
- Direct attendees to the correct session room/bathroom/lunch areas.
- Direct attendees to trade displays and/or the Quiet Area.
- Liaise with the In-Room Volunteers.
- Assist with providing tourist information and guidance, if required.
- Follow MCG First Aid/OHS requirements at all times.
